„Kinshasa Symphony“ receives the Audience Award at „Festival des Deutschen Films“

Beautiful weather at the weekend – the cinema seats and deckchairs at the river Rhine are almost completely occupied. On Saturday, the 26th of June, nearly a thousand people poured into the festival cinema of the “Festival des deutschen Films“ in Ludwigshafen, Germany, to watch “Kinshasa Symphony”. Also on the following day the screening was nearly sold out despite it being shown at the same time as the deciding World Cup match between England and Germany.

At the award ceremony on Sunday evening, at which „Kinshasa Symphony“ won the Audience Award, the director of the festival, Dr. Michael Kötz, said to director Claus Wischmann: „You had nearly 700 people in the cinema today, and that during one of the big World Cup matches! You definitely missed out! “

The ARD-Coproduction „Kinshasa Symphony“ will take part in several festival competitions this year such as at the Durban International Film Festival, in South Korea, in Vancouver and at Rhode Island Festival.
